

Silvana Community Fair Youth Scholarship

Scholarships in the amount of twenty-five-hundred dollars (\$2500) may be awarded to 2025 high school graduates who have exhibited at the Silvana Community Fair for at least three years, reside in Snohomish, Island or Skagit County, and intend to further their education in either a college, trade, technical, or vocational school. Winners will be announced at the 2025 Silvana Fair on July 26, 2025.

The scholarship package should contain:

- Completed application (see next page)
- Short essay (300-500 words). Please edit your essay for grammar and consistency. Judges may not know you so please paint a clear picture of yourself. In your essay, please include:
 - Your future plans.
 - How participating in the Silvana Community Fair influenced your educational/career choices.
 - How you plan to support the Silvana Community Fair in the future.
 - How this scholarship will help you further your educational goals.
- A minimum of one and a maximum of two letters of reference written on your behalf by a non-family member. Ask the writer to send the letter to the same address as your application (see below).

12. Write a short essay or story (300-500 words - preferably typed) identifying your future plans and giving your reasons for wishing to pursue the field you have chosen. Also, include in this essay how being involved with the Silvana Fair has influenced your educational/career choice and how this scholarship will help you achieve your educational goals. Please use a separate sheet for this essay and sign your name at the bottom of the page.
