SILVANA FAIR BUCKET/BOTTLE CALF PROJECT

PURPOSES

- 1. To teach proper health care, environmental needs and nutritional requirements of young cattle.
- 2. To teach basic beef/dairy management skills without a large investment.
- 3. To teach basic record keeping and communication skills.
- 4. To provide a better understanding of the cattle industry.

BUCKET/BOTTLE CALF PROJECT GUIDELINES

- 1. Project is open to youth 5-9 years of age. Exceptions made at superintendent's discretion.
- Any newborn or orphan calf ... steer, bull, or heifer ... beef, dairy, or cross Purebred or crossbred and must have calved on or after January 1st and be at least 4 months old by the fair date. Exceptions on a case by case basis. Contact the superintendent with questions.
- 3. Calf must be bucket or bottle fed. No nursing permitted.
- 4. These calves are only eligible to be shown in the bucket/bottle calf class.
- 5. Calves must be identified with an ear tag on bucket/bottle identification sheet.
- 6. Bucket/bottle calf record book and poster to be submitted.
- 7. Must obtain calf between birth and 10 days of age.

PROJECT EVALUATION

1. The project will be scored based on four parts that can score a maximum of 200 points:

Written Records	100
Oral Interview (while showing)	50
General Health and Well-being	25
Showmanship and Fitting	25

- 2. Record Book should be completed and brought to the superintendent at the fairgrounds on the day of the fair.
- 3. General health, fitting and showmanship will be evaluated during the fair in a show ring evaluation.
- 4. Ribbon placing will be based on overall points given for the written records, general health and well-being, fitting and showmanship. Champion and reserve champion awards in Bucket/Bottle Calf class will be based on overall points.

SILVANA FAIR REQUIREMENTS

- Calves will be shown at halter and fitted according to beef or dairy guidelines. The class, if needed, will be divided according to age of exhibitor as of October 1st of the previous year. At the discretion of the superintendent, further class divisions may be made based on number of entries.
- 2. Judging of the bucket/Bottle Calf class will be based on:
 - Exhibitor's knowledge of care and management of raising the calf.
 - The fitting and showing of the calf with emphasis on what the exhibitor has learned.
 - General health, condition and management of the calf and exhibitor's knowledge of the project.
 - Completeness of Record Book to an age-appropriate level.
- 3. Exhibitors are encouraged to keep animals and enter them in the appropriate beef or dairy class at the next year's fair.

- 13. Who funded your project?




